



THE 2ND WUSHU SANDA ASIAN CUP

REGULATIONS

Jilin, China

July 2 – 7, 2025

A. DATE AND PLACE

The 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup will be held from July 2 to 7, 2025 in Jilin, China.

B. VENUE

1. Competition venue: Songyuan Gymnasium
2. Training venue: Songyuan Gymnasium

C. COMPETITION EVENTS

1. Men's:
48Kg, 52Kg, 56Kg, 60Kg, 65Kg, 70Kg, 75Kg, 80Kg, 85Kg, 90Kg, and 90Kg+;
2. Women's:
48Kg, 52Kg, 56Kg, 60Kg, 65Kg, 70Kg, and 75Kg.

D. QUALIFICATIONS

1. The top 3 placed athletes (including 3rd place juxtaposed) from the 10th Asian Wushu Championships under above listed Article C Competition Events are qualified to participate. All qualified athletes are listed as attachment.
2. Each team can have no more than 12 participating athletes.
3. Those athletes that have qualified but do not compete in the Wushu Sanda Asian Cup will be replaced by participants appointed by the WFA.
4. Each qualified athlete must be submitted into the Asian Cup by WFA Members.
5. In-quota accompanying Team Officials (including Team Leader, Coach, Doctor):
 - a. Teams that have 1-3 qualified athletes may submit 2 team officials at most.
 - b. Teams that have 4-5 qualified athletes may submit 3 team officials at most.
 - c. Teams that have 6-7 qualified athletes may submit 4 team officials at most.
 - d. Teams that have 8 or more qualified athletes may submit 5 team officials at most.
6. Each team may send 1 team judge.

E. ENTRY METHOD

1. Each qualified competitor may only participate in the events he or she has qualified for.
2. The remaining vacated events will be filled by participants appointed by the WFA.
3. Each competitor should bring along with them a valid Health Certificate (including electroencephalogram, electrocardiogram, pulse and blood pressure) issued within 15 days prior to the start of the competition signed by a qualified doctor and a Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate. All competitors are required to submit a completed and signed waiver of liabilities form.

F. COMPETITION METHODS

1. The single knockout system will be adopted. If the number of competitors in a given weight category is three (3) or less, a single round-robin method will be adopted.
2. Following arrival and registration, athletes will undergo an initial weighing-in and drawing-lots as stipulated in the schedule.
3. Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the "Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Method 2024" endorsed by IWUF. The interpretation of the rules is at the discretion of the IWUF. In case of any disagreement in the interpretation of the rules due to language versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.

G. COSTUME AND EQUIPMENT

1. Competition
 - All teams must follow the IWUF Brand Control Guidelines for Wushu Competition Uniforms.
 - Competitors shall wear costumes and protective gear in compliance with the rules to participate in the competition.
 - For Wushu Sanda Asian Cup, men's athletes will not wear head guards and chest protectors.
 - Each competitor is required to possess their own mouth guard, hand wraps, jockstrap and two (2) sets of competition costumes: one set in blue and one set in red.
 - Competition gloves, women's athletes' head guards and chest protectors will be provided by the Organizing Committee.
2. Ceremonies
 - All teams must wear their official national/regional team uniforms during the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.
 - Medalists should wear their national/regional team uniforms to the Awarding Ceremony.
 - Athletes should remove their off caps/ hats during the ceremony.
 - Athletes and officials are not allowed to bring any religious symbols into or on the awarding podium.

H. PLACING AND AWARDS

1. The top 3 athletes of each weight category will be awarded.

- 1st place: Gold Medal, Certificate & USD 1,500.00 Prize Money.
- 2nd place: Silver Medal, Certificate & USD 1,000.00 Prize Money.
- 3rd place: Bronze Medal, Certificate & USD 500.00 Prize Money.

The prize money is after tax.

2. Awarding Ceremony

- Ten minutes before the Awarding Ceremony, the medalists will be escorted by staff to the Waiting Area to get ready for the ceremony. Medalists must wear their team's official uniforms.
- The medalists are required to attend the Awarding Ceremony. In case a medalist is unable to attend the ceremony for a valid reason, his/her medal and certificate may be presented to an official of the relevant delegation. Absence without a valid reason will forfeit the right to receive a medal. The medalists are not allowed to bring any religious symbols to or onto the podium.
- If there are fewer than three (3) medalists in a single event, no Awarding Ceremony will be held for that event. One of their team officials will go to the designated place to receive the medals and certificates.

I. ENTRIES

1. The preliminary entries and final entries must be submitted through the WFA Online Registration System. All sections of the online entry must be completed in full, including the uploading of those required documents.

2. Preliminary Entry

- The deadline for the preliminary entry is April 5, 2025, at 23:59 (Beijing Time).
- The preliminary entry forms must be sent by e-mail to the Organizing Committee and the WFA Secretariat.
- All teams must complete the preliminary entry before the deadline to access the final entry system.

3. Final Entry

- The deadline for the final entry is May 22, 2025, at 23:59 (Beijing Time).
- The final entry forms must be signed by either the President or Secretary-General of the member association with seal, and to be sent by e-mail to the Organizing Committee and WFA.
- Each team is required to print a copy of the submitted entry and present it upon arrival and registration.

4. Late Registrant and Changes Policy

- The deadline for late registration and changes is due on June 5, 2025, at 23:59 (Beijing time).
- Late registration requires a fee of US\$100.00 per person.
- Member Associations with requests for late registration or changes must submit a written document to WFA for approval and shall pay corresponding fees before the late registration deadline, otherwise request will be denied.

J. REGISTRATION

1. All judges (including team judges) are required to arrive and register at the designated registration by July 2, 2025.
2. All participating teams are required to arrive at the designated registration and register with the 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup Organizing Committee no later than July 3, 2025.
3. Upon arrival, the participating team is required to complete the accreditation process with the Organizing Committee. Accreditation cards will be given to the team upon completion of the accreditation process. All personnel must participate in the official activities with their accreditation card during the event.

K. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT & TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

1. The Organizing Committee shall be responsible for the organization of the championships under the guidance of the WFA Executive Committee and Technical Committee.
2. Each participating team may send one team judge. Technical Delegate, Jury of Appeals, and designated judges will be appointed by the WFA.
3. All technical officials (including Technical Delegate, Jury of Appeals, designated judges and team judges) must present their valid certificates issued by IWUF upon registration. Judges must have participated in and passed the examination of the 2023 or 2024 IWUF International Judges Certification & Training Course and have participated in the 2025 Asian Wushu Training Course (for judges), to qualify to judge at the 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup.

L. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

1. The international airfare and related travel expenses of all participating athletes, team officials, team judges and observers shall be borne by the teams themselves.
2. Participating Teams: The Organizing Committee will provide accommodation for qualified participating athletes and in-quota team officials from July 3 to 7, 2025. All observers will be responsible for their own accommodation expenses.
3. Technical Officials: All travel expenses for Technical Delegate, Jury of Appeal and designated judges will be borne by the Organizing Committee. The Organizing Committee will provide accommodation for Technical Officials (including team judges) from July 2 to 7, 2025.

4. The Organizing Committee will arrange the accommodation and transportation for participating teams from July 3 to 7, 2025. If any team is arriving earlier or departing later than the required date, they should inform the Organizing Committee before June 5, 2025, to arrange their accommodation arrangements. Participants arriving early or departing late may be subject to additional costs related thereto which shall be borne by the participants themselves.
5. The WFA and Organizing Committee require that all participating teams lodge must be at the designated hotels.
6. Payment Methods

- Participating teams are required to pay the relevant participation fees by international wire transfer along with their final entry submission. Following the submission of a final entry, the Organizing Committee will contact each team and provide them with their invoice, which will state the total and bank/ payment details. Teams are then required to transfer the full amount as stated on the invoice. All international wire transfer and bank fees are to be paid by the teams transferring the funds themselves. Proof of full payment should be sent to the Organizing Committee via email and carried along to the site by the team. The Organizing Committee requires that all participation fees are to be paid in advance to secure accommodation as required by the official hotels.
- Teams unable to pay by international bank transfer must inform both the WFA and the Organizing Committee in advance, and with approval, payment must be paid in full upon arrival registration.

7. Fees

Based on the relevant provisions of Article 12 (2) and (4), the standards for room and board fees (unit: US dollars, only US dollars are supported) are as follows:

Room Types	In-quota members (per person per night)	Observer (per person per night)
Double	USD 90.00	USD 100.00
Single	USD 100.00	USD 110.00

Remarks: In-quota members refer to participating athletes and in-quota team officials, observer refers to exceeding team officials.

M. WEIGH-IN

1. The initial weighing-in will take place at 07:00 (Beijing Time) on July 4, 2025, location is to be announced.
2. Athletes participating in the competitions on the same day must weigh in at the specified time before the competition, with location to be determined.
3. Athletes must present their accreditation card and passport during the weigh-in, and the absence of either is not allowed.
4. Competitors will be disqualified if their weighing results do not meet the requirements of the weight category they have entered.

N. TECHNICAL MEETING

1. The Technical Meeting will take place at 09:00 (Beijing time) on July 4, 2025. Matters related to the competition will be announced during the meeting.
2. Each team may send 2 representatives (team leader or coach) to attend the meeting.

O. DRAWING-LOTS CEREMONY

1. The drawing of lots will take place right after the Technical Meeting.
2. Each team may send 2 representatives (team leader or coach). For teams unable to attend, the representative of the Jury of Appeal will draw on their behalf.

P. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be conducted during the 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup according to the requirements of the IOC and World Anti-Doping Agency and will follow the procedure prescribed in the IWUF Anti-Doping Rules. The number of tests will be decided by the WFA. If an athlete is found to have positively doped through the doping process, he/she will be dealt with in accordance with the IWUF Anti-Doping Rules.

Q. OTHER MATTERS

NFs are responsible for their officials, coaches, athletes, and observers adhering to the WFA and to all relevant rules established by the WFA and the Organizing Committee. NFs should ensure that their participants hold themselves to the highest standards in all their actions during the event.

1. Fundamental Principles

All NFs Team members participating in the 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup must observe and respect the WFA constitution, rules, regulations, and representatives. Individuals deemed to have acted against the WFA, its principles, interests or purpose may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation.

2. Attitude of Athletes and Coaches

The athletes will compete under the responsibility of their NFs. NFs are fully responsible regarding the general attitude and comportment of their athletes. Coaches should respect the judging panel, and all complaints must be conducted in accordance with competition procedures. Athletes and Coaches should comply with the IWUF Ethic Codes.

3. Image of Athletes

Each NF is responsible for obtaining the rights for the WFA to use its athletes' images at the discretion of the WFA for promotional purposes in all forms.

4. Insurance

Each NF is fully and sole responsible for insuring its athletes against injury and third-party risk (public liability) during the period of the 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup. The WFA and the Organizing Committee are not responsible in part or in whole for the said liability.

5. The team must submit the following information to the organizing committee when registering:

- 3 x National, Regional or Association flags (1 meter x 2 meters).
- National or Association anthem (short version) MP3 format on USB.
- Athlete valid Health Certificate.
- Athlete Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate.
- Completed and signed "Waiver of Liabilities" of the 2nd Wushu Sanda Asian Cup by each participant.
- Signed and stamped final registration form.
- Fee payment receipt (if applicable).
