With the endorsement of Asian University Sports Federation (AUSF), the 2024 Asian University Wushu Championship, to be held from 19th to 22th June in Harbin, China, will be organized by the China Student Sports Federation and the Heilongjiang Provincial Sports Administration of China, and supported by the Wushu Federation of Asia.

I. Host City



Harbin, located in the northeast of China, in the southwest of Heilongjiang Province, the provincial capital of Heilongjiang Province, a sub-provincial city in China, is the

center of politics, economy and culture in Northeast China and also a mega city coming first in the area of land under jurisdiction and coming third in registered population among the provincial cities in China. Its special historical course and geographical location have created an exotic beautiful city, Harbin, which has not only brought together the history and culture of northern ethnic minorities but also integrated Chinese and foreign cultures. It is a famous historical and cultural city and tourist city in China, also known as "the Ice City". The whole city covers an area of 53,100 square km (including an urban area of 10,198 square km), occupying 0.55% of the country's land area, with its population occupying 0.7% of the country's total population.

4.3. Competition System

4.3.1 Taolu

4.3.1.1 The competition order is determined through a draw conducted on-site during the General Technical Meeting.

4.3.1.2 Optional events are scored according to the 2019 International Wushu Optional Rules; Traditional events are scored according to the 2019 International Wushu Traditional Rules. All Taolu routines are scored using A Group-Quality of movements Scoring and B Group-Overall Performance scoring only.

4.3.1.3 Traditional barehanded routine events are ranked by group; traditional weapons are ranked separately.

4.3.1.4 Taiji events are ranked based on the following four categories:

-42-Form barehanded Taiji routine

-Other barehanded Taiji routine: Chen Style, Yang Style, Sun Style, Wu(吴) Style, Wu (武) Style

-42-Form Taiji sword

-Other Taiji weapons

4.3.1.5 Time Requirement for barehanded Taiji routine: 3-4 minutes, with the signal of the referee's whistle at the 3-minute; time requirement for other Taiji weapons: 2-3 minutes, with the signal of the referee's whistle at the 2-minute.

4.3.1.6 Time requirement for each of the Duilian event is no less than 50 seconds.

4.3.2 Sanda

4.3.2.1 The competition order is determined through a draw conducted on-site during the General Technical Meeting.

4.3.2.2 The latest rules--"Wushu Sanda competition Rules & Judging Method" by IWUF will be implemented.

4.3.2.3 The competition is an individual event and the single elimination format will be implemented.

4.4 Attire and Equipment

The attire and equipment shall be prepared according to the rules of international Wushu competitions.

4.4.1 Taolu

4.4.1.1 The attire worn and equipment used by competitors must comply with the rules of the regulations.

4.4.1.2 Competitors must prepare their own attire and equipment.

4.4.2 Sanda

4.4.2.1 Competitors must wear attire and protective gear that comply with the rules of the competition.

4.4.2.2 Competitors must bring their own competition attire and foot protectors, one red set and one blue set.

4.4.2.3 Competitors must bring their own gum-shields, jockstraps and hand wraps.

4.4.2.4 The organizing committee will provide gloves and protective gear (head guard, chest guard).

4.5 Ranking and Awards

- **Taolu**

- 1st Place: Gold medal and certificate.
- 2nd Place: Silver medal and certificate.
- 3rd Place: Bronze medal and certificate.
- 4th to 8th Place: Certificate.

- **Sanda**

- 1st Place: Gold medal and certificate.
- 2nd Place: Silver medal and certificate.
- 3rd Place (**juxtaposition**): Bronze medal and certificate.
- 5th to 8th Place: Certificate.

4.6 Competition Required Documents

4.6.1 Physical Examination Certificate of the competitors, including EEG, ECG, blood pressure, pulse. The physical examination certificate must be valid within 15 days before the competition.

4.6.2 Original Personal Insurance Certificate for competitors.

4.6.3 Signed Waiver form (Referring to the attachment).

4.7 Arbitration of the Competition

The Jury of Appeal is composed of the CISCA Chair of AUSF, the Technical Delegate,

the Chief Referee, and other personnel. If there is any objection to the ruling, the team leader or his delegate can submit an appeal to the Jury of the Appeal in writing within 30 minutes after the competition, with an appeal fee of \$50. If the appeal is accepted, the fee will be refunded.

4.8 Competition Registration System

Each delegation should create an account first. An email on approval notice will be received. Once it is done, the system could be logged in and the personal data and competition events of the all the delegation could be filled in. It is guaranteed that all the data and information on the system just used for the competition only.

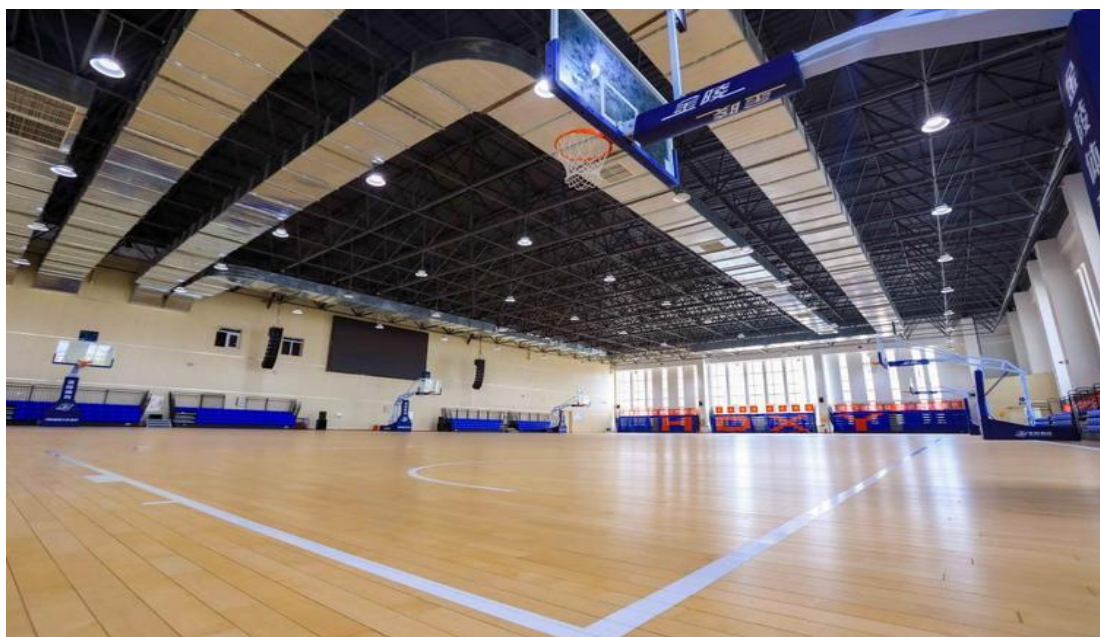
The deadline for competition registration is on or before **May 31st, 2024**.

4.10 Anti-doping

Dope testing will take place during the competition according to current AUSF Anti-Doping Rules.

The organization committee will follow the WADA Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations- Guidelines and Operations Procedures. AUSF is committed to dope free sport, and strictly follows the enclosed guidelines and procedures of WADA approved Anti-Doping guidelines and procedures for the safety of our athletes and fairness of play for our sport.

V. Travel

The official points of arrival & departure are Harbin Taiping International Airport (HRB), Harbin Railway Station and Harbin West Railway Station.

5.1 The trip to and from the official points of arrival & departure should be arranged and funded by the participating teams.

5.2 Transportation between the official points of arrival & departure and the accommodation place, as well as all other transport related to official program will be arranged by the Organizing Committee. The distance between the competition venue and hotel is 0.8 km, within walking distance.

VI. Visa Application

6.1 Except for visa-free persons as specified, foreigners who participate in this Championship shall apply for Chinese visa from the embassy or consulates of China in their countries (regions), or any other institute authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China. 6.2 The delegation that need to apply for visa must provide requested personal information and passport copies and submit to OC before **24 May at the latest**, after receiving the relevant information, OC will issue the invitation letters as soon as possible.

VII. Financial Conditions

7.1 The Organizing Committee of Asian University Wushu Championships will arrange the accommodation and local transportation for participating teams from June 17-23, 2024 and collect the participation fee with the amount of USD60 per person per day. For extra officials, the participation fee is **USD 120** per person per day. For extra stay of the whole delegation, that is, arriving before 17 June or departing later than 23 June, the participation fee for this period will be **USD 120** per person per day, The OC must be informed of the number of extra officials and days of extra stays before May 31, 2024, so that the OC could help to book the rooms accordingly.

7.2 The registration fee for AUSF is **USD10** per person (**USD20** per person for non-AUSF members), which will be collected by AUSF Secretariat **in cash** upon accreditation.

7.3. The OC will provide first-aid service. The delegation must buy insurance for its members. Insurance at least covers civil liability, material losses, injuries and medical expenses. Any expenses arising from hospital visits and treatment should be paid by the insurance or the participants themselves.

7.4 Asian University Sports Federation and the Organizing Committee of Asian University Wushu Championships request that all participating teams lodge at the designated hotels arranged. Those who cannot participate in the activities and competitions on time due to their own reasons shall take responsibility for consequences arising as a result of this.

7.5 Payment method

In order to secure accommodation, teams are required to transfer 100% of participation fees to the account established by the Organizing Committee before 31st May 2024.
